

Objectives of the association

The Association is non-profit. Its aim is to protect the interests of its members. In particular, the Association intends:

- a) to examine and resolve issues of a technical, fiscal, legal, administrative, and organizational nature of common interest to its members;
- b) to organize study conferences for the examination of issues of common interest, including medical-sports aspects, using the collaboration of experts in the field appointed by the President and/or the Board of Directors;
- c) to cooperate with other Entities, Associations, and Governing Bodies to solve problems that, directly or indirectly, concern the activities of Nautical Clubs, Marinas, and Tourist Ports;
- d) to provide, utilizing experts appointed by the Board of Directors, consulting services for the interpretation and application of laws, regulations, and rules concerning the sector;
- e) to promote and implement, directly or indirectly, any initiative deemed useful to increase the influx of sports and recreational boats into Nautical Clubs, Marinas, and Tourist Ports, both domestic and foreign;
- f) to facilitate the signing of contracts and collective agreements of an economic and/or regulatory nature concerning subordinate employment in the Associated Clubs and related companies or concerning the activities referred to in letter a) of this article;
- g) to promote studies and projects related to the development of Nautical Clubs in Campania;
- h) to promote the creation of networks for the development of common interests among Nautical Clubs, the Campania Region, coastal authorities, and economic activities;
- i) to promote the implementation of joint protocols between public administrations of municipalities in Campania and cooperation for mutual growth;
- j) to promote the formation of new professional skills in the sectors of nautical clubs, boating, and nautical tourism, as well as national and international conferences and seminars in the field of nautical tourism;
- k) to manage directly or through training bodies projects to be proposed to public and private entities, both national and community-based;
- l) to promote projects for the protection of the sea, rivers, lakes, the environment, and the coast;
- m) to produce, distribute, and disseminate scientific, technical, cultural, educational materials through any means of communication to foster the development, organization, and promotion of water sports or activities connected to the sea, as well as the dissemination of maritime culture, solidarity, and the safeguarding of human life at sea, and the protection of the marine, lake, river, and coastal environment;
- n) to produce printed materials, including periodicals, educational materials, audiovisuals, films, and other relevant materials related to the social purpose;
- o) to manage social, cultural, and promotional activities and any other initiatives with local territorial entities, workplaces, institutions, universities, aimed at spreading the culture of protection and promotion of the marine and coastal environment;
- p) to carry out initiatives and monitoring campaigns, including involving volunteers and citizens directly, for example through citizen science, to defend the marine and coastal environment, territory, landscape, marine life, soil, and seabeds, as well as climate change;
- q) to carry out environmental and health education activities for schools, including campaigns and initiatives to extend knowledge of environmentally and naturally significant areas;
- r) to promote, implement, and organize activities and initiatives aimed at meeting the primary needs of the population, safeguarding human life, developing motor and sports practices for all for physical and mental well-being, enhancing human, natural, and cultural resources, building development alternatives based on the "blue economy," and protecting environmental values, including involving vulnerable and disadvantaged groups;
- s) to promote and support volunteer and citizen associations' experiences, safeguard, recover, and

enhance the territory and natural and cultural resources for the defense of the coastal, lake, river, and maritime environment, overcoming all forms of hardship, social and cultural discrimination; t) to organize and manage cultural, artistic, or recreational activities of social interest, including activities, even editorial, for the promotion and dissemination of culture and volunteerism and other activities of general interest as per art. 3.

In this perspective, the Association promotes the culture of Universal Civil Service through projects aimed at involving young people in promoting volunteerism as a tool for active citizenship and participation in the protection and safeguarding of environmental, historical, artistic, and cultural heritage, as well as promoting education and cultural, landscape, environmental, sports, and sustainable and social tourism.

For these purposes, the Association may join other non-profit organizations that can facilitate the achievement of its objectives.

The activities described above, or those directly connected to them, are mainly aimed at third parties and are carried out continuously, primarily through the voluntary and free personal services of its members.

In case of necessity and if possible, it may hire employees or make use of self-employed services, including through its members, within the limits set by the New Third Sector Code.

The Association may carry out activities other than those of general interest but instrumental and secondary to them, according to what is provided by current regulations regarding the third sector and as determined by the Association's Board of Directors.

The association may exercise, pursuant to art. 6 of the Third Sector Code, activities different from those of general interest, secondary and instrumental to these, according to criteria and limits defined by a specific Ministerial Decree. Their identification is carried out by the governing body. The association may also carry out fundraising activities, respecting principles of truth, transparency, and fairness towards supporters and the public, in accordance with the provisions of art. 7 of Legislative Decree 117/2017.
